## UNIVERSAL PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD

The *UNIVERSAL PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD* will be used as the student identification; library services and lunch card as long as you are a student at Red Bank Regional High School. All "first issue" cards are free of charge. **See below regarding "Replacement of Lost Cards."** 

## USE OF YOUR UNIVERSAL ID CARD IN THE CAFETERIA

A cafeteria account has been set up for each student enrolled at RBRHS. You may activate your account by making a deposit of money to be used for meals and each time you make a purchase, it will automatically be deducted from your account. Deposits may be made with any cashier in the cafeteria by cash or check. Funds may be earmarked for the purchase of meals only, meals and/or a la Carte, or in snack bar. Checks should be made payable to RBRHS Cafeteria.

Note: Cash is always accepted for any purchase made in the cafeteria/snack bar.

If you were eligible for the **Free or Reduced Lunch** program last school year, you are eligible for the benefits 30 operating days from the first day of school. The *UNIVERSAL ID CARD* must be presented in the cafeteria in order to obtain meals for which you are eligible. A new application must be submitted within 10 days of receipt of the new application in order to be considered for free or reduced lunch for the current school year. An application for the current school year is enclosed for your convenience.

If a card is left at home or lost, meals must be paid for in cash at the time of purchase whether or not there is a balance in the account or an individual is eligible for free or reduced benefits. The card must be presented at time of purchase – no exceptions are permitted.

## REPLACEMENT OF LOST CARDS

If your *UNIVERSAL ID CARD* is lost, report the loss in the Principal's office immediately. Your account number will be charged so that the account cannot be accessed. A new card will be issued within a week after you have reported it missing. A fee will be assessed for replacement of card.

Keep the Universal Identification card in a safe place; it is an important part of your daily routine in school.

\*If your child is Direct Certified (foster child or TANF or Food Stamp recipient) an application is not needed.
